













#### **Team Structure**



**Professional Mentors** are critical to FIRST Robotics Competition (FRC) teams. Our students work side by side with engineers, programmers, marketing professionals, and more to learn the skills they need to make Pirate Robotics successful.

We are seeking professional mentors with expertise in the following areas for the **2019-2020** season:

#### **Engineering & Manufacturing**

- Provide feedback during the design process
- Help our students prototype and build the robot in the workshop
- Commitment: at least 3 afternoons per week January 4 February 18, 2020

#### **Programming**

- Help our programming team use Java, C++, or LabVIEW to program the robot.
